



## Bones Bay

A very smooth wall of limestone a short walk from Doolin village. There is potential for more problems further left on the cliff but the tide would need to be low.

## Conditions

The listed problems are climbable at any tide.

## Approach

From the cross roads at Fitzpatrick's Pub take the road that passes Aille River Hostel, follow the road until it ends, 50m further on is the beach, the cliff is on the right.

From left to right.

- 1 - 6a Long reach off a good crimp for the right hand.

- 2 - 5 Start on the slopy rail.  
 3 - 6a Big reach off undercut pocket to a slopy dish and slap for the break. Nice highball.  
 4 - 4 The left crack.  
 5 - 5 The right crack.  
 6 - 6a Pull on and slap for the break.  
 7 - P Pull into the groove and throw for the break.
